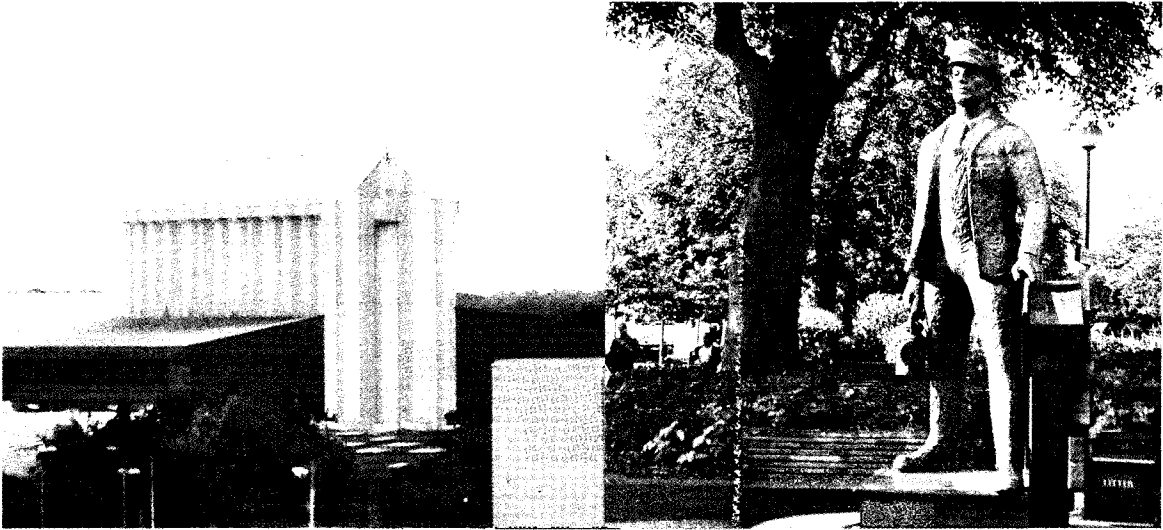
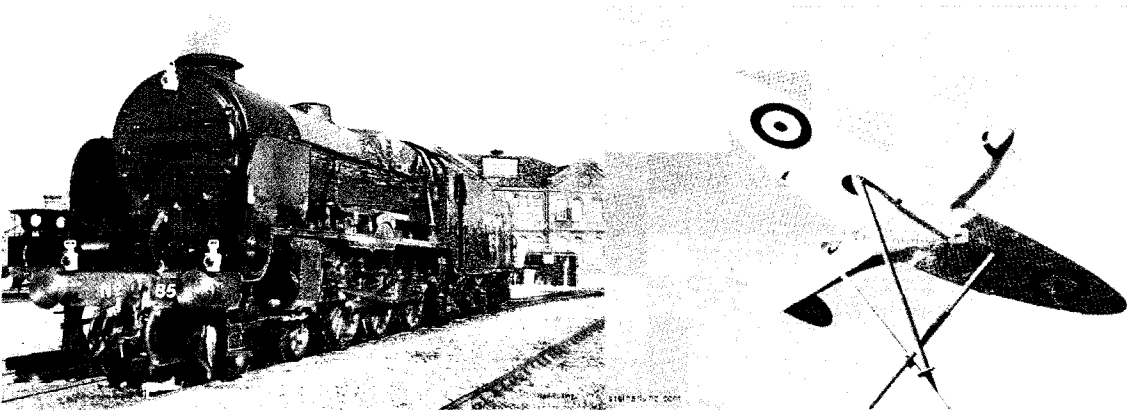

The following extracts from the minutes of Eastleigh Borough Council mention the National Service Hostels Corporation Ltd., a government quango

Council Minutes 13th November 1941.

63. TEMPORARY HOSTELS.—Councillor Quilley reported upon a Meeting which had taken place at the Civic Centre, Southampton, on 24th October, 1941, presided over by the Mayor of Southampton, and at which Representatives of the Ministries of Health and Home Security and other bodies had attended. Lord Rushcliffe, as Chairman of the National Service Hostels Corporation, Ltd., made an appeal for the co-operation of local authorities and local leaders of industry. The two camps in our area would be staffed on the 15th November next, but it was intended to employ the homeless in occupation in various ways. Admission could only be gained on production of a special ticket to be issued at Rest Centres, and to qualify for such a ticket a person must (a) be engaged on work of national importance and (b) be homeless. The words "work of national importance" are being defined by a Sub-Committee set up for this purpose.

As regards Sanitary and Health matters, an assurance was given that the Council staff would be consulted so far as the two hostels in our area are concerned.

As to shelter provision and recreational facilities, it was apparent that nothing would be done, although these matters were brought to the notice of the Ministry of Health some time ago.

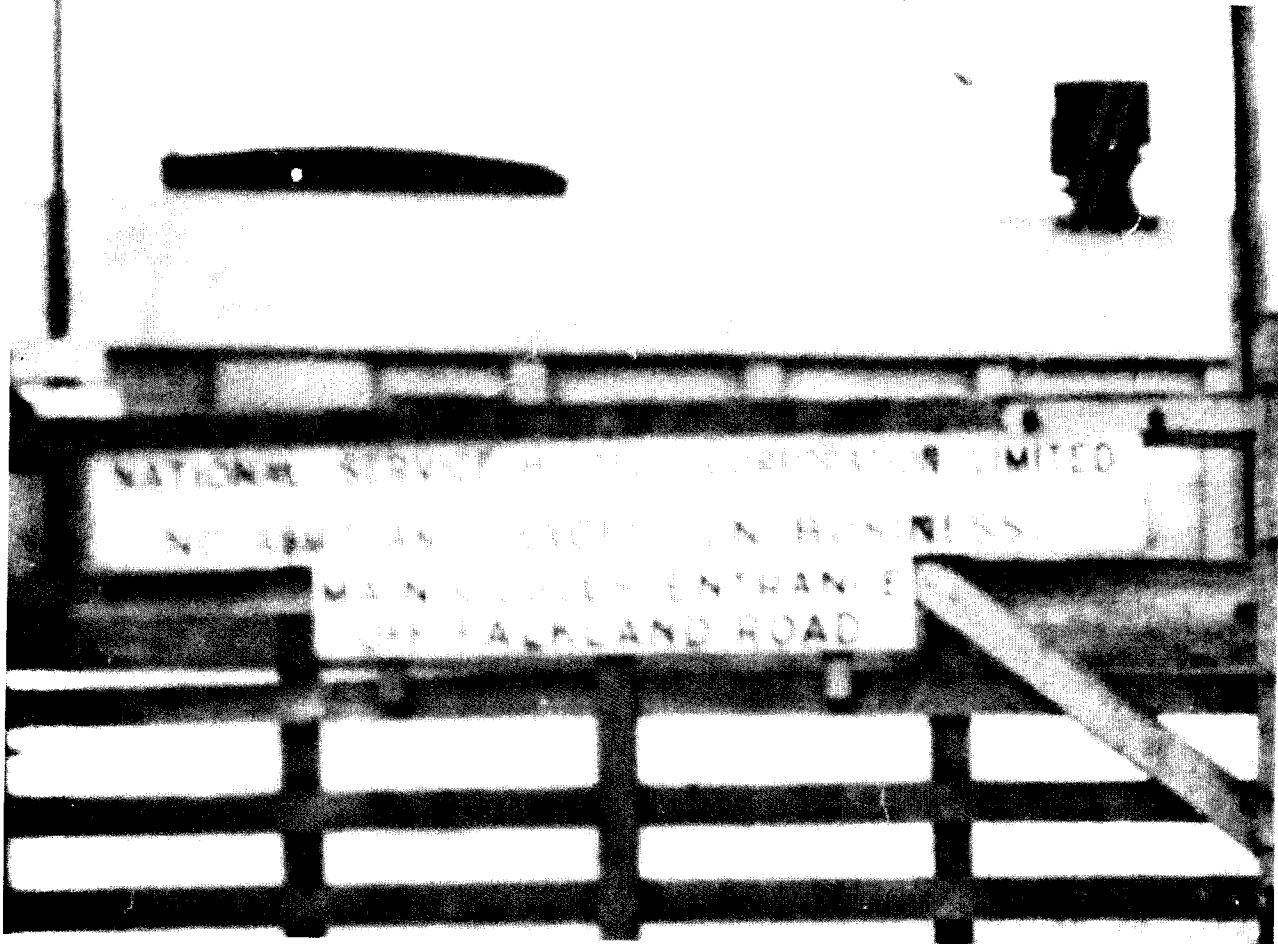

114. TEMPORARY HOSTELS.—63/11/41. The Town Clerk reported that he had received a letter herein dated 19/11/41 from the Senior Regional Officer, Ministry of Health, a summary of which is as follows:—

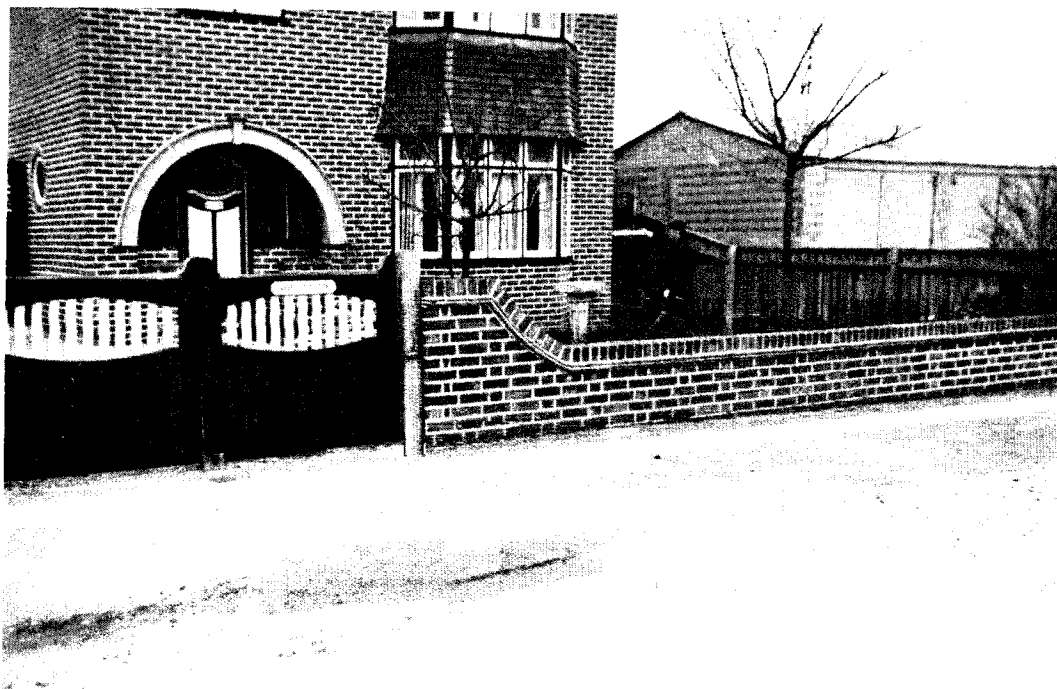
- (1) There is no intention that the huts should continue to be occupied after the war and indeed it is not intended that they should be in permanent occupation during the war.
- (2) No alterations or additions to the camps will be made without consultation with the Council.
- (3) An adequate nucleus staff will be in residence and will be increased as necessary.
- (4) Much importance will be attached to the maintenance of a high standard of hygiene and sanitation and the co-operation of the Council is desired in this matter.
- (5) No departure has been made from the decision that shelters will not be provided.
- (6) Welfare Officers and voluntary helpers will deal with questions such as that of recreation for children when the need arises.

The secrecy surrounding the hostels is unhelpful. It would have been helpful to have been told where the two camps mentioned were and who had built them.

One Camp run by the National Services Hostel Corporation Ltd., has been found.

£50 in Fines

A total of £50 in fines, and £7.10s. in costs, was imposed when ten men were before the court on summonses for failure to produce their ration books in order that food coupons could be invalidated by the licensee of a National Service hostel at Chandler's Ford.

Defendants, each fined £5 and 15s. costs. were : James Bolton, Frank Lillington, Frank Timson, Charles J. Bishop, Sidney Marlow, Peter Fox, Ernest A. Griffiths, Harry Rivett, Anthony Gair and Harry Fox, all of Velmore Camp, Chandler's Ford.

Mr. R. M. Brooks, who prosecuted for the Ministry of Food, said that when the men went to live at Velmore Camp, Chandler's Ford, they were asked to give up their ration books, and if they were not given up then it was found almost impossible to obtain possession of the documents because the men paid for their meals at the hostel as they had them. Notices were posted in the camp warning residents that if they remained there for more than five days a week they must give up their ration books. When interviewed on September 18th the defendants made various excuses. In most cases it was found that the tea coupons or points, or both had been used for the period when the men were living in the hostel and obtaining most of their meals in canteens.

The Chairman, who said the offences were of a very serious nature, mentioned that the maximum penalty was a fine of £500 or twelve months in prison or both.

Rivett, who pleaded not guilty said he had not used any coupons in respect of the period he was at the hostel, and he intended to ask his M.P. to raise the matter in the House of Commons. He also asked if he had a right to appeal.

Changed Address

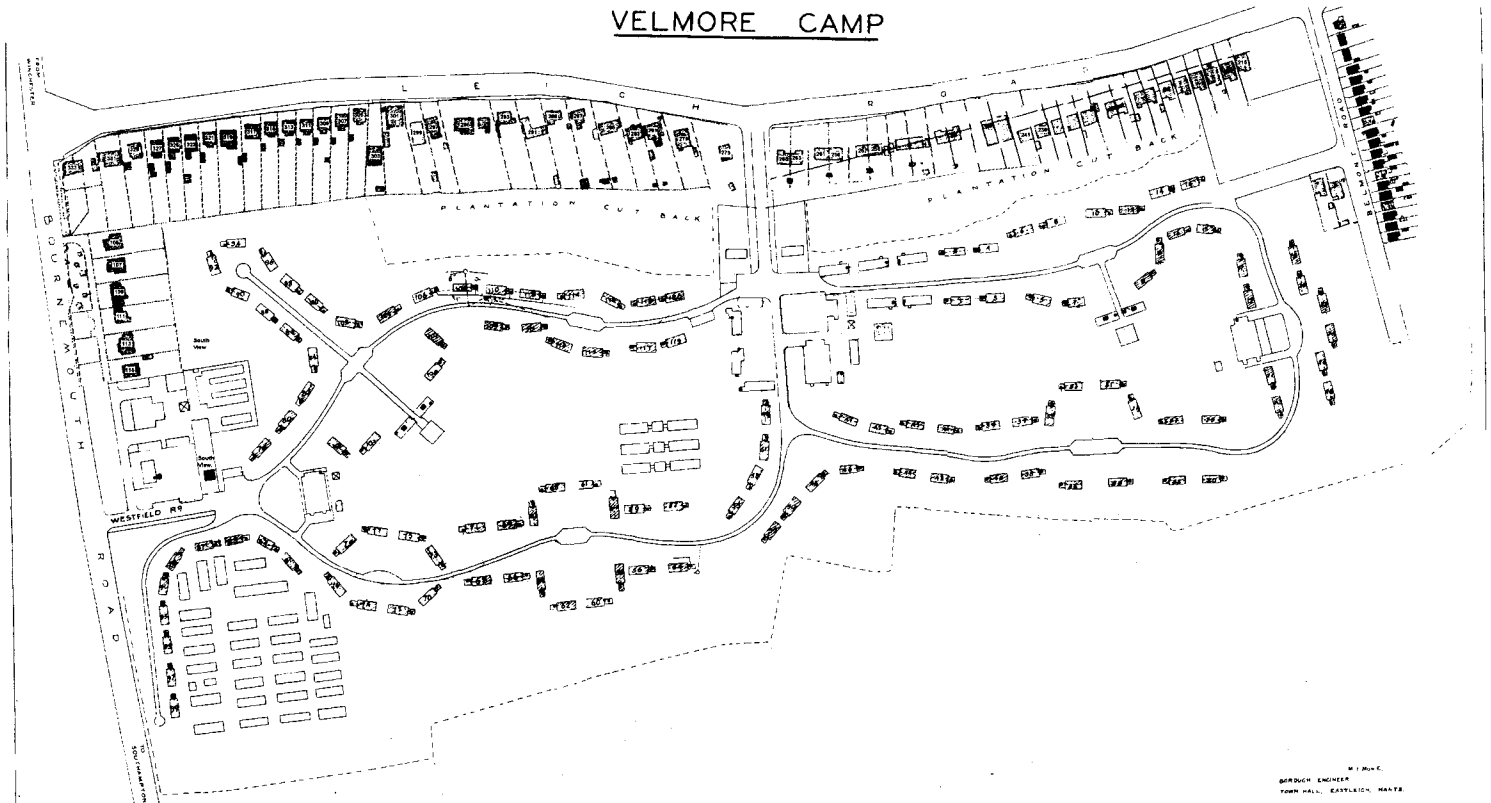
Summoned for not notifying their change of address, Francis Deveraux, Robert Valentine and William Corben, all of Velmore Camp hostel, were each ordered to pay a fine of ten shillings. For a similar offence, the following were each fined five shillings: — Peter Fox, Sidney Marlow, George Walter Kemp, Anthony Gair, Henry Dodd, Frederick Lanfear, George Honour, Frank Dixon, Frank Lillington, Thomas White, Henry A. Dennis, Oswald Brooks, Francis Billington, Arthur Oliver, Walter Chapman, George Doige, Frank Tilston, Frank Gardner, William Luker, Harry Fox, Aubrey Valis, Walter H. Keenor, Harry Rivett and Peter Ward.

Instructed by their Union, Mr. C. F. Hiscock represented fifteen of the men. Some of them, he said, had handed their identity cards to a welfare officer when they left the Redbridge Training Centre, and they were apparently under the impression that that officer would see to the necessary notification as to change of address. The men had worked long hours on work of national importance, seven days a week, and they had had no desire to break the law.

It is rumoured that the Camp had at some time been used to house Italian Prisoners of War but there is no evidence for this. There were camps in Romsey and Bishops Waltham, and it is also rumoured that there were Italian prisoners living in a large house in Chandler's Ford. Italian prisoners were collaborators and as such the International Red Cross did not inspect their camps. People have reported seeing their working parties in the Borough as the men wore a distinctive brown uniform with a yellow circle on the back

The Eastleigh Borough Rate Books mention a hostel in Leigh Road which may have later become known as Velmore Camp. After the War, housing was desperately needed so the Council organised work on the services in the Camp to bring it up to standard.

The Council produced a plan when it provided a water supply, electricity and drainage for the buildings. Removing all the technical detail revealed a map of the camp with hut numbers.

- (2) **TENANTS—HUTTED CAMPS.**—We have considered a report from the Borough Treasurer dealing with the policy to be adopted in selecting tenants for hutted camps and **recommend** :—
- (a) That in general the persons selected should be those who would in any case be housed in a permanent house at about the time when it expected that the camp will have to be given up.
 - (b) That a small number of hutments be reserved for extremely urgent cases of overcrowding or bad conditions.

1112. **VELMORE CAMP, CHANDLER'S FORD.**—The Town Clerk submitted a letter received from the Principal Housing Officer, Reading, informing us that part of Velmore Camp, Chandler's Ford, had been declared redundant to service needs and suggesting that the Council should inspect the site and decide whether the huts are suitable for housing purposes.

The Chairman reported that a delegation from the Housing Allocation Sub-Committee had already inspected the site which contained 66 Tarran Huts, 37 Plasterboard Huts, Kitchen, Dining Room, Bath-house, Laundry, Warden's Bungalow and Warden's Office Building, and members of the delegation informed us of their views as a result of the inspection.

After a full discussion we have agreed that the Chief Sanitary Inspector be instructed to carry out a thorough inspection of the huts and buildings on the site now referred to, and to submit a report thereon, if possible, at the meeting of the Council in Committee.

In 1949 part of VELMORE INDUSTRIAL HOSTEL was still in use.

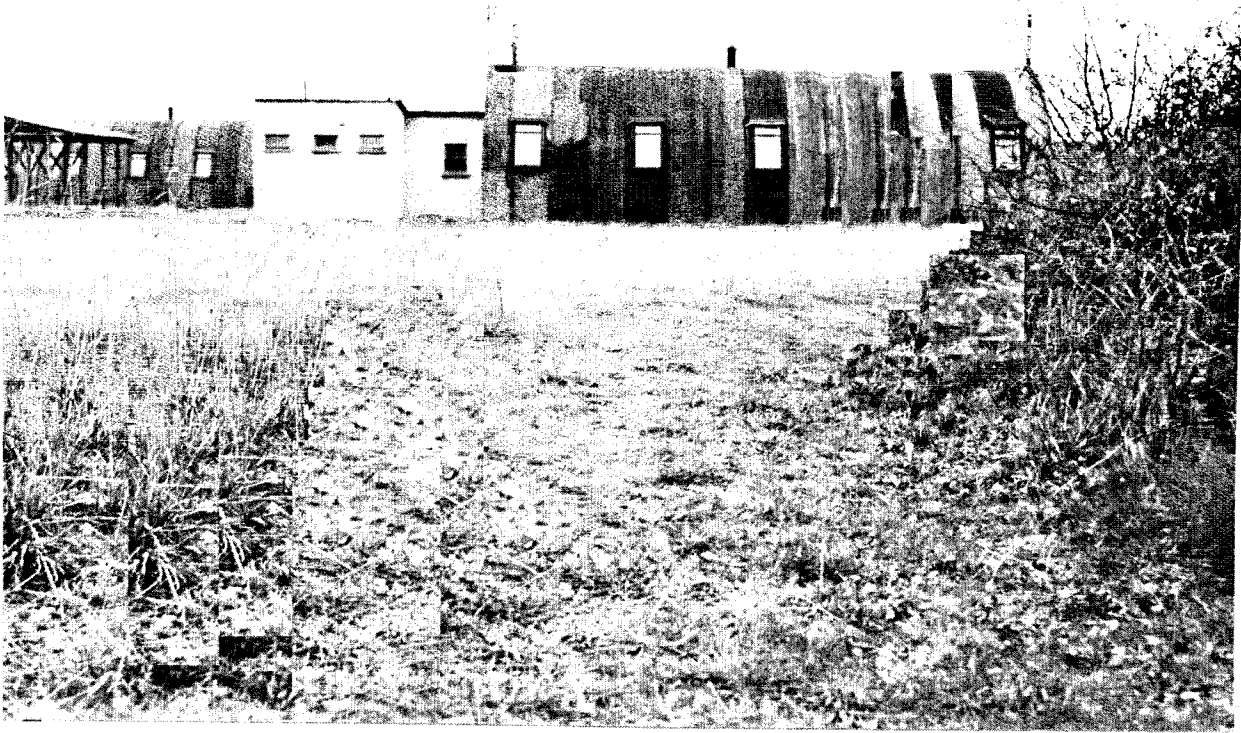

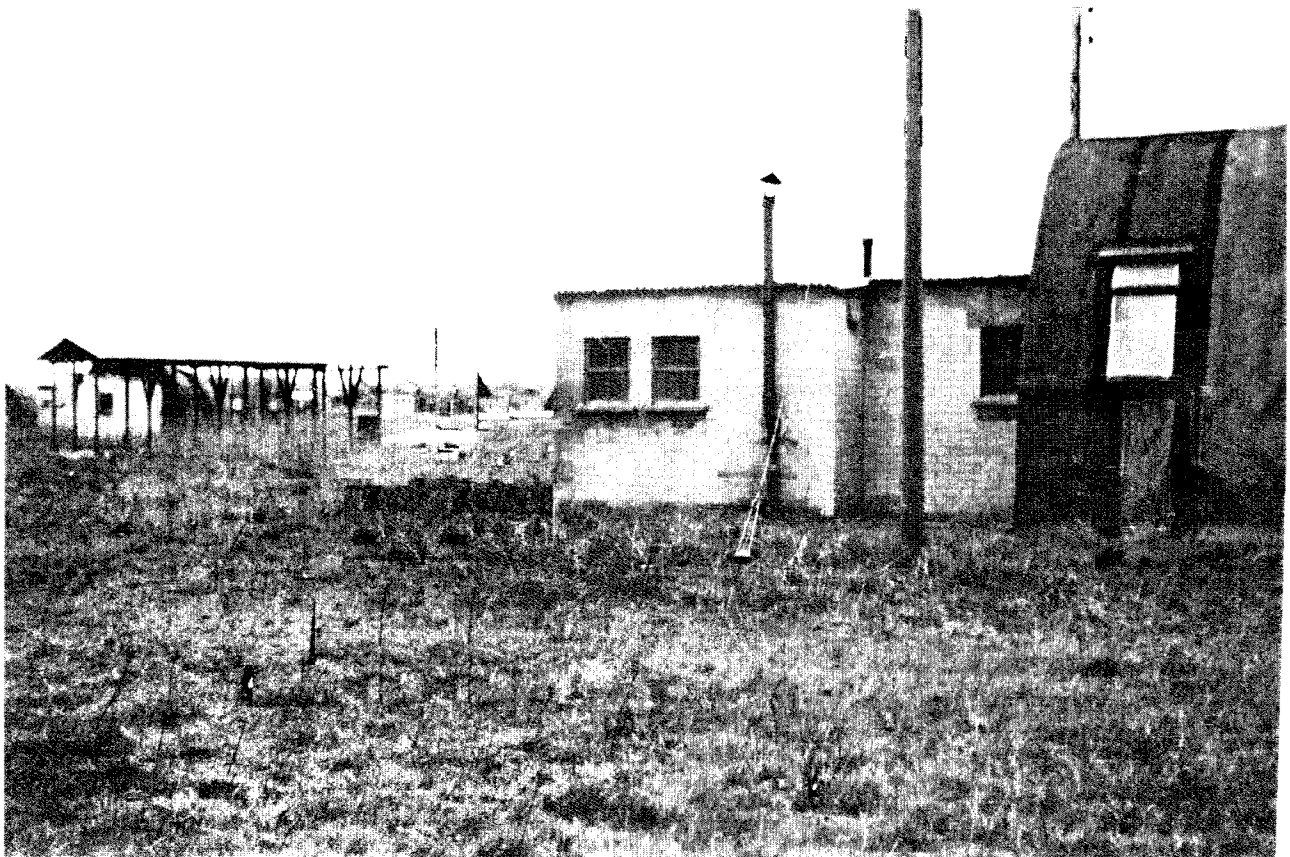

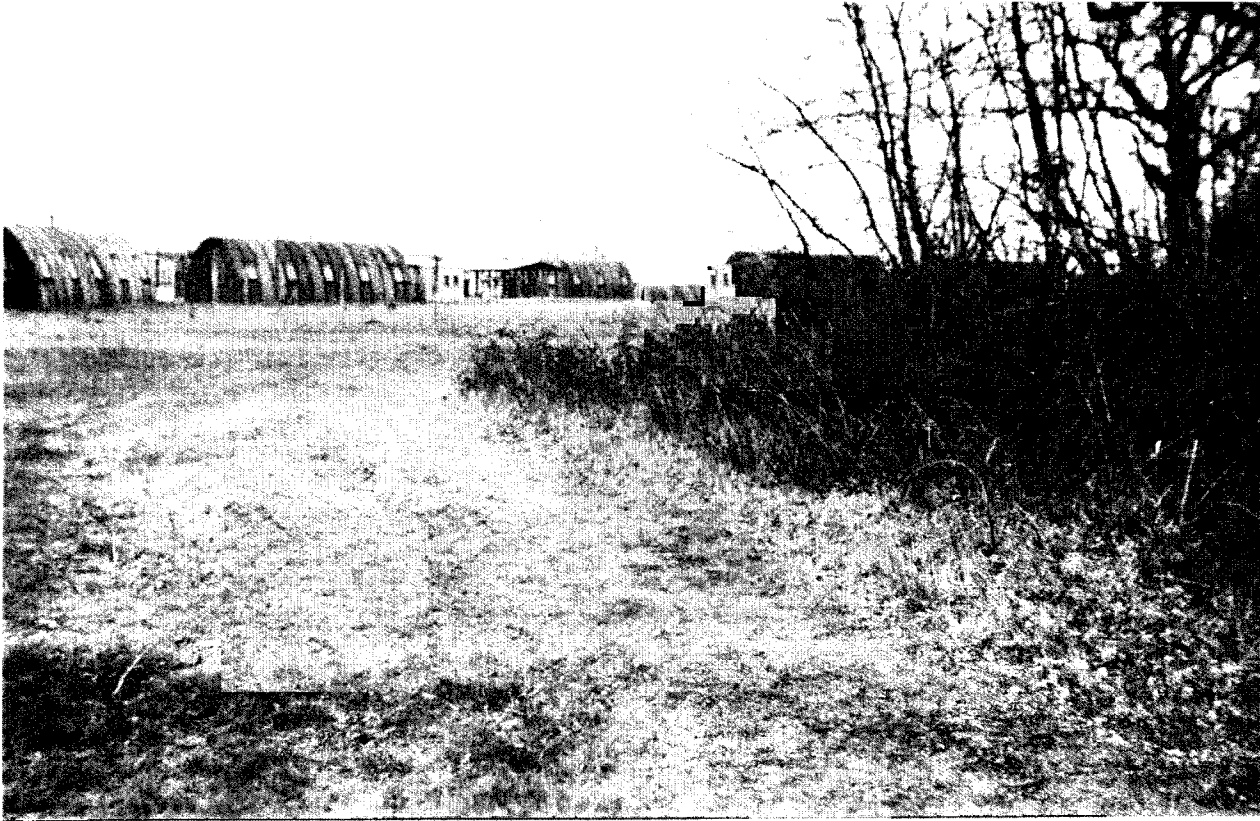

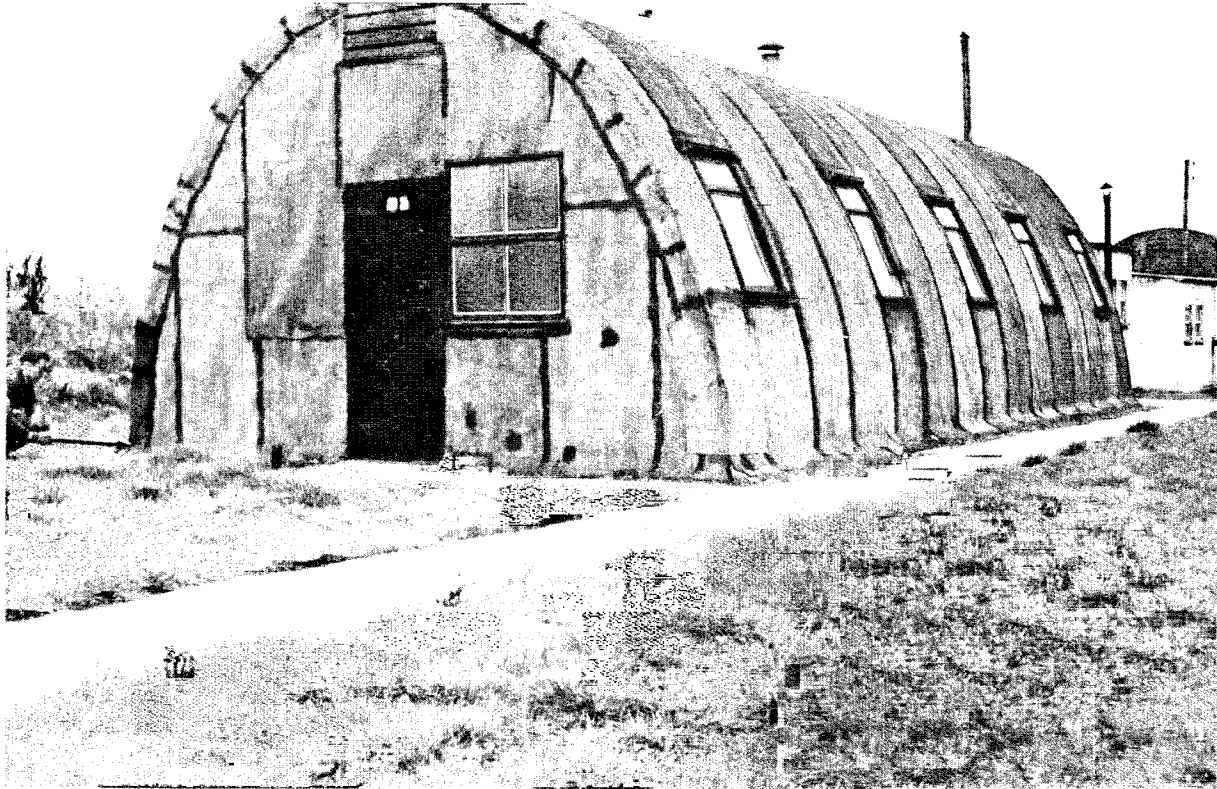

There had been no intention that the huts would continue to be occupied after the war but the Borough Council changed its mind and in 1948 started to prepare them to house homeless families. It appears that those so housed were moved into real houses as soon as they became available.

The hut numbering became more complicated and some buildings known as Stoneham Flats must have been built, and I notice that ‘Chippy’ Wood, one of the Mathematics masters at Eastleigh County High School was among the residents. He later moved to East Drive in Bishopstoke.

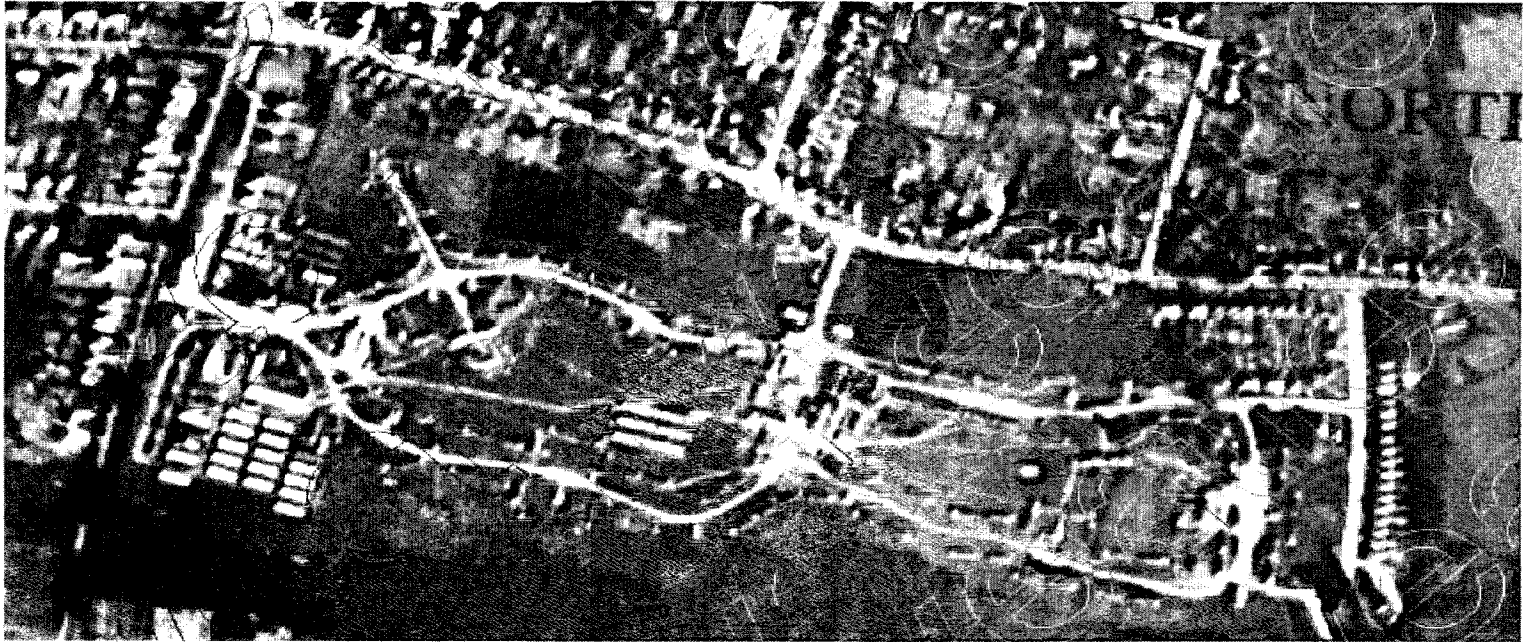
